## **GUEST BAG DROP & CHECK IN**

Caddie Master Kevin Gannon and his staff will take your bag at the drive-through bag drop across from the main clubhouse. Please provide them with your host's name. They will direct you to the locker room, off the pro shop. Danny Sanchez in the men's locker room or Reina Melendez in the women's locker room will provide you with a locker.

## **DRIVING RANGE**

Please feel free to arrive early and take advantage of our practice range. The range is short and we ask that you not hit clubs that will send balls outside range boundaries (we also provide limited flight golf balls to hit).

## **CADDIES**

We encourage you to take a caddie. This great Tillinghast layout can be best appreciated on foot. If you choose to take a cart, please consider a forecaddie. Kevin Gannon and his staff or Head Professional Brad Worthington and his staff will arrange for one. Caddies and carts are provided with a sand/seed mix to be poured into divot holes or to touch up a replaced divot. Thanks for taking care of the course.

## **PACE OF PLAY**

Your round should take four hours or less. We let faster groups play through. Your host may suggest this if your group should fall behind more than one hole due to pace of play or searching for a lost ball.

## **DRESS CODE**

Accepted attire consists of a collared golf shirt or blouse and slacks. Bermuda-length shorts are also permissible. Blue jeans/denim of any style, cargo pants or shorts, shirts without collars, short-shorts or mini-skirts are not permitted. Only golf shoes with non-metal spikes are permitted. If your shoes have metal spikes, your locker room attendant will be happy to replace them. Shirrtails must be tucked in. Gentleman are asked to remove their hats in the clubhouse, exceptions being the pro shop or locker room.

## **ELECTRONIC DEVICES**

Cellular phones, pagers and other electronic devices are prohibited on the golf course, but allowed in the locker rooms and the parking lot. The use of GPS distance devices are allowed, unless
